



Texan Glenn Lee Elected to National PGA Board of Directors

Horseshoe Bay, Texas PGA Member to Represent Northern Texas, Southern Texas and Sun Country PGA Sections as District 12 Director

PALM BEACH GARDENS, Fla. (Nov. 13, 2015) – Glenn Lee, General Manager of Escondido Golf and Lake Club in Horseshoe Bay, Texas, has joined the PGA Board of Directors as District 12 Director. He was elected to the Board today at the 99th PGA Annual Meeting at PGA National Resort & Spa and will serve a three-year term representing the Northern Texas, Southern Texas and Sun Country PGA Sections.

Lee is an Honorary Past President, President, Vice President and Secretary of the Southern Texas PGA Section (STPGA), and served on the STPGA's Board of Directors for four years. Additionally, Lee was the 2012 and 2005 STPGA Golf Professional of the Year recipient, the 2013 STPGA Bill Strausbaugh Award winner and served as captain of the STPGA team for the 2014 Texas Joe Black Cup.

"It has been an honor to represent not only my Section, but the North Texas Section during my career," said Lee. "I remember watching with great admiration as Randy Smith represented District 12, and Ronny Glanton served as the Director of the North Texas Section. I never could have imagined that I would have an opportunity to follow in their footsteps. Recent District 12 Directors, Dan Koesters and Alan Wooley, have also offered their support and wisdom, both of which have greatly impacted my outlook on National governance. With these fantastic legacies serving as a beacon, I cannot wait to get to work on behalf of my fellow Professionals from our three proud Sections.

A native of San Antonio, Lee is an alum of Stephen F. Austin University, where he studied Business Administration. He began his career at the Plano Municipal Golf Course as an Assistant Golf Professional in 1985. Elected to PGA Membership in 1991, while an assistant golf professional at Royal Oaks Country Club in Dallas, Lee was mentored by Randy Smith, who has won more national awards than any other PGA member. Early in his career, Lee served as president of the Northern Texas PGA (NTPGA) Assistants Association from 1988–90; the NTPGA's Apprentice Chairman from 1992–94; on the NTPGA Junior Golf Committee in 1994; and was named the NTPGA Assistant Golf Professional of the Year for 1989.

In 1995, Lee relocated to Austin, Texas, to become the PGA Head Golf Professional at The Hills Country Club. Lee became a PGA Director of Golf in 1999, and managed in both this capacity and

as Clubhouse Manager. In 2002, Lee returned to The Hills Country Club where he served as Regional Director of Golf. He was a member of ClubCorp's National Golf Advisory Committee from 2002–07, and was instrumental in the selection of The Hills Signature Course as host of the PGA Champions Tour FedEx Kinko's Classic.

In 2007, Lee was recruited to Horseshoe Bay Resort as the PGA Director of Golf, where he oversaw a 72-hole Country Club. In 2012, he became General Manager of Escondido Golf and Lake Club and is currently guiding Escondido in the transition from a management club to an equity club for its members.

Lee and his wife, Jennifer, live in Horseshoe Bay, Texas. They are the parents of four daughters: Jessica, Katy, Leah and Vanessa; son Tyler and four grandsons.

The PGA Board of Directors is composed of the Association's president, vice president, secretary, honorary president, and 17 directors. The directors include representatives from each of the PGA's 14 districts, two Independent Directors and a member of the PGA Tour. New District Directors are elected by their local PGA Sections.
